The Lions of the British Isles and Ireland have raised hundreds of thousands of pounds to bring health and a future to the children of the former Yugoslavia.

In the early days very sick children were flown out of the stricken land to be treated in hospitals in Great Britain and Ireland, and returned home healthy and happy.

The Lions moved on, going into the heart of what was still a war zone to bring help to this troubled country; hospitals have been provided with sophisticated equipment for the care of very sick babies and children; a mobile clinic is in operation; simple handbooks teaching basic healthcare have been produced in the local languages; British and Irish medical staff have worked alongside



local doctors and nurses, helping and encouraging them; local medical professionals have been trained in paediatric care, some of them being financed to study in hospitals in our Multiple District.

The Lions reward? Many hundreds of healthy children who would otherwise have had no chance of survival.

These children are the future of a traumatised nation on our own doorstep. Help 'Lions - A' Gift for Living' to go on helping them.

'Our Doctors' – In a land where the infrastructure of medical care has been severely damaged, where doctors and nurses have been prevented from refining their skills for many years due to the war and where babies were dying needlessly from lack of
